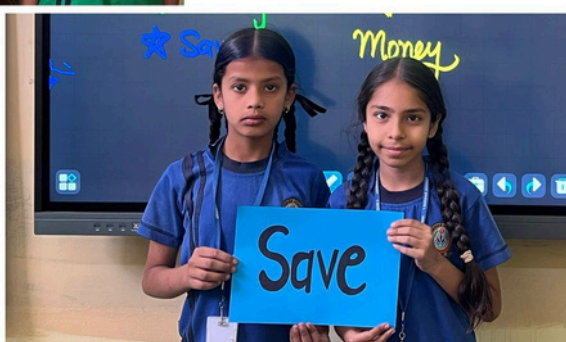

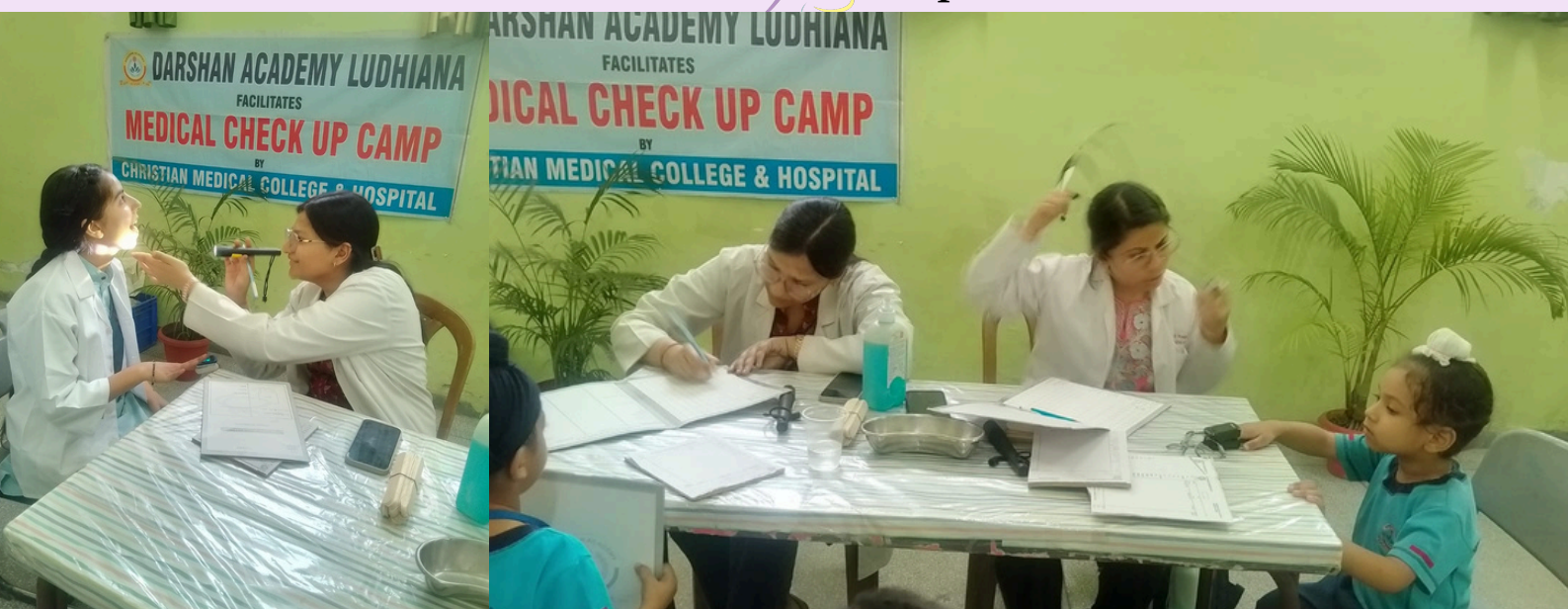

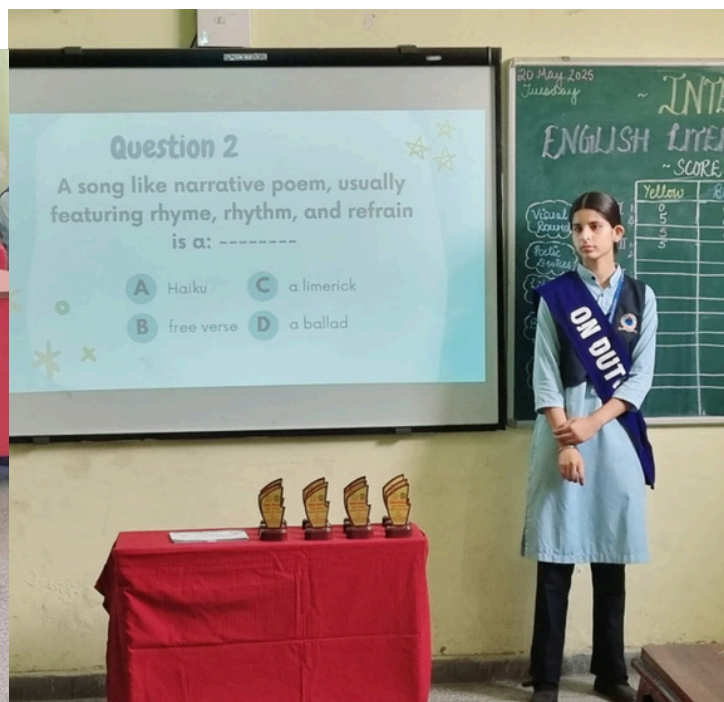
Mother's Day Celebration

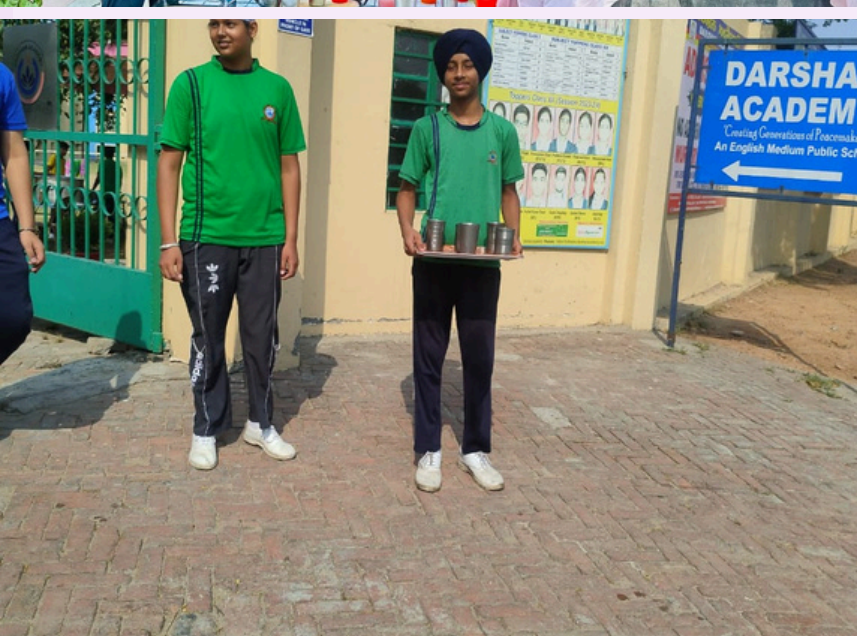
Reverse Mock Drill

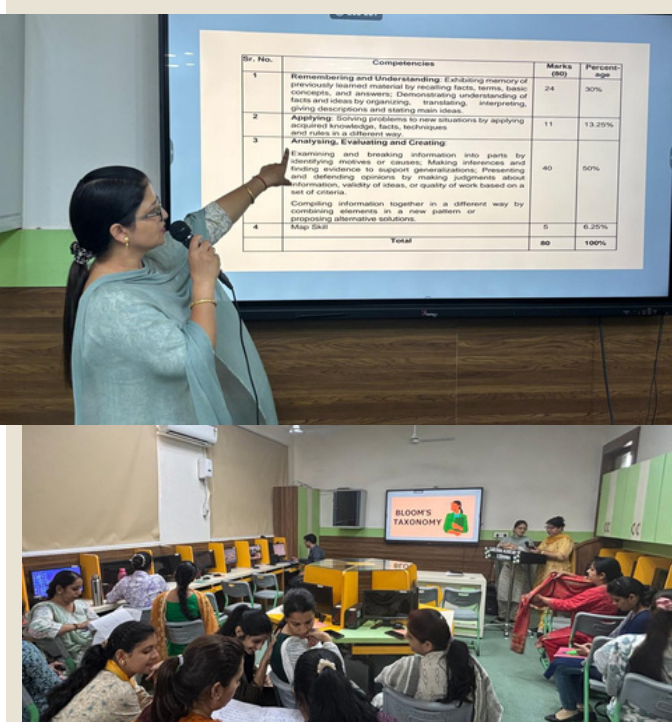
Storytelling in Teaching

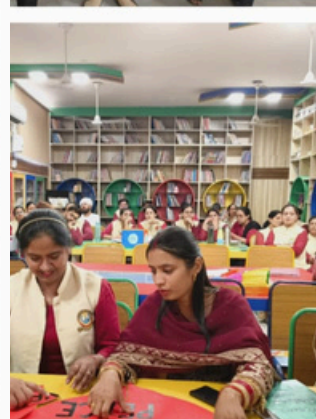
Bloom's Taxonomy

All six levels—Remember, Understand, Apply, Analyze, Evaluate, and Create—were explained using classroom-based examples through a PPT. Teachers were then asked to apply these levels to a topic from their respective subjects, promoting hands-on learning. The session focused on integrating the taxonomy into lesson planning and assessment designing. Teachers participated actively and gained clarity on its application in question papers. The Principal appreciated the initiative and encouraged the use of Bloom's Taxonomy to foster critical thinking and deeper student engagement.



Spiritual Curriculum Session – Teaching Aids

A session on Teaching Aids was organized at Darshan Academy, Ludhiana as a part of the spiritual curriculum enhancement for teachers on 6 June 2025. They demonstrated how stories can be structured to align with each level of Bloom’s hierarchy—Remembering, Understanding, Applying, Analyzing, Evaluating, and Creating—thereby fostering critical and creative thinking in students. A key highlight of the session was its subject-specific focus. Teachers were introduced to innovative ways of integrating storytelling into the teaching of core subjects like Geography, Science, and Mathematics. Interactive group activities such as story weaving, clue-based narration, and theme-based story creation encouraged teachers to collaborate and experiment with creative pedagogies. The atmosphere was vibrant and filled with enthusiasm as participants discovered new ways to inspire their students through the art of storytelling. The Principal and faculty of BCM School appreciated the depth and practicality of the session, applauding the efforts of both speakers in enriching the teaching-learning experience. 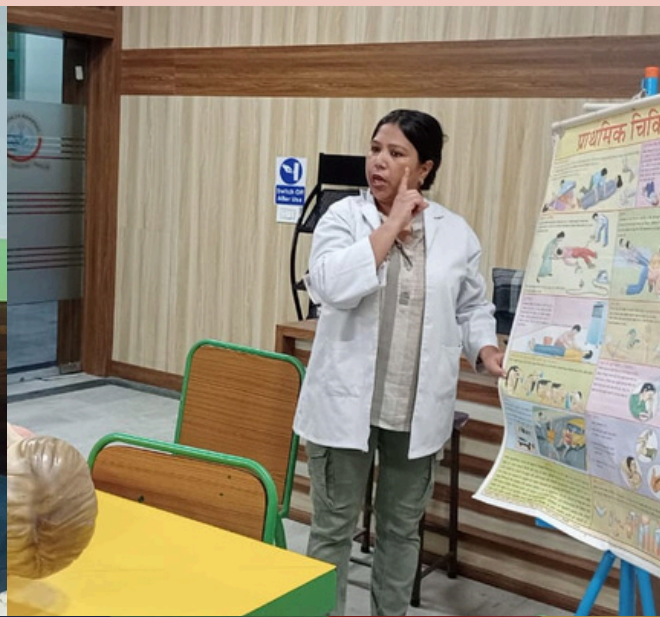

Karate Championships

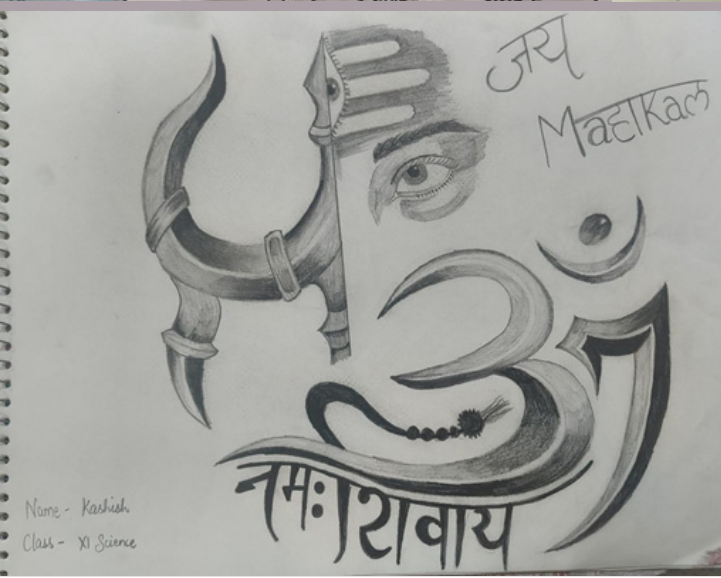
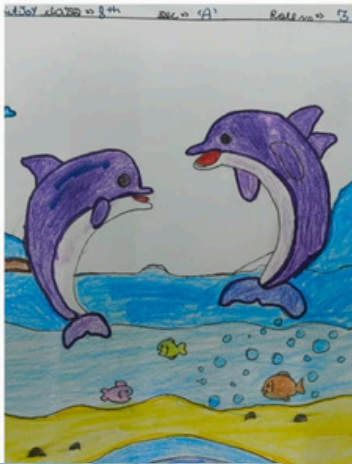
