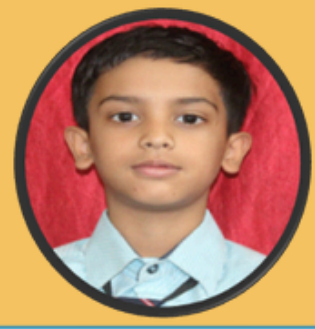

# Book Review Workshop

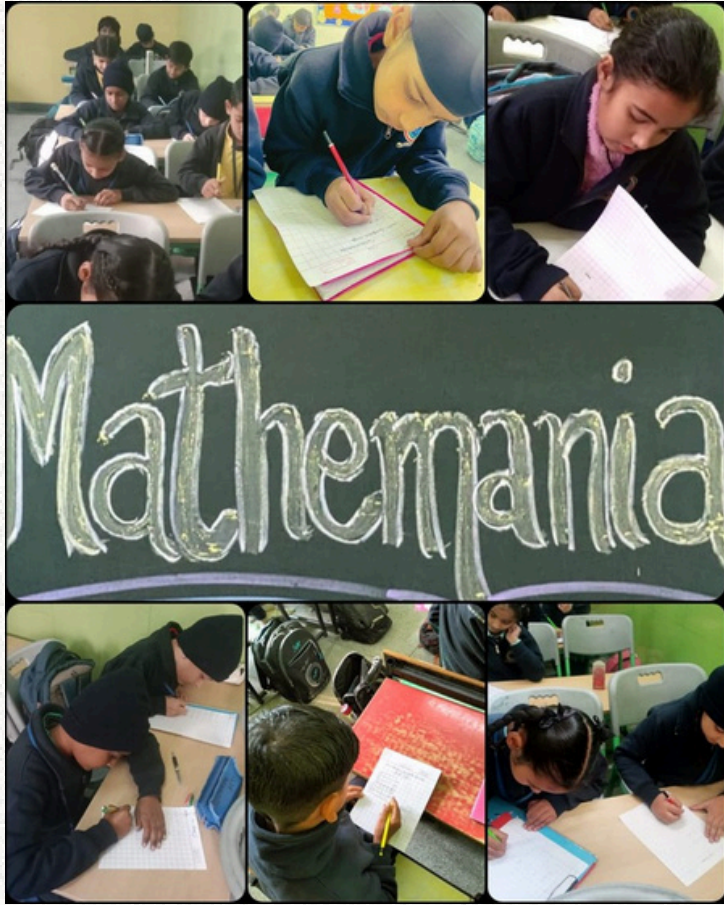

# बाल कवि दरबार

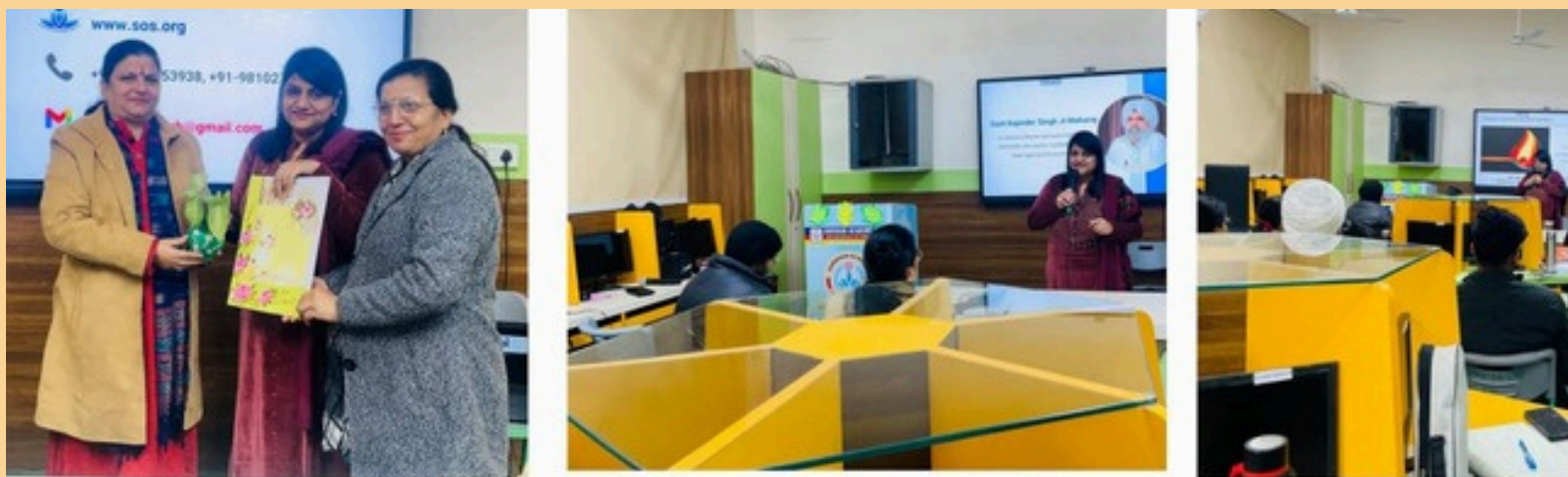

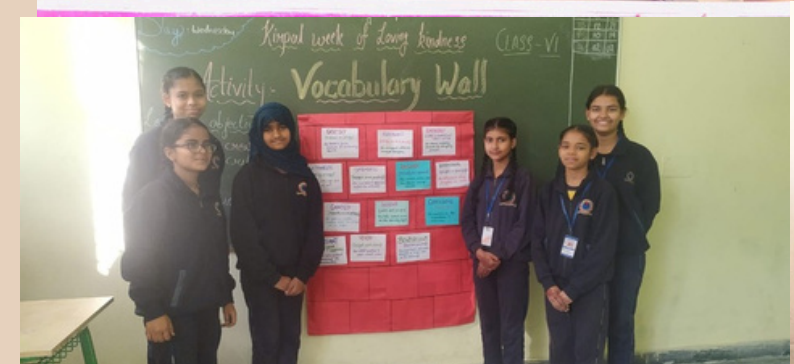
# Kindergarten Graduation Ceremony

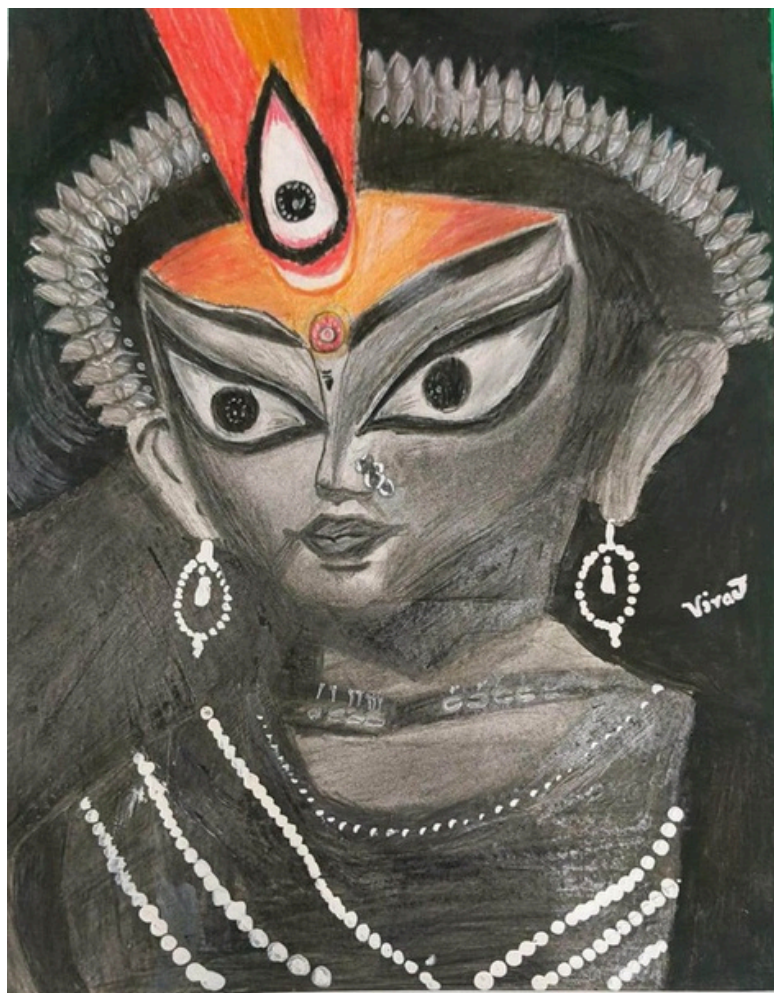

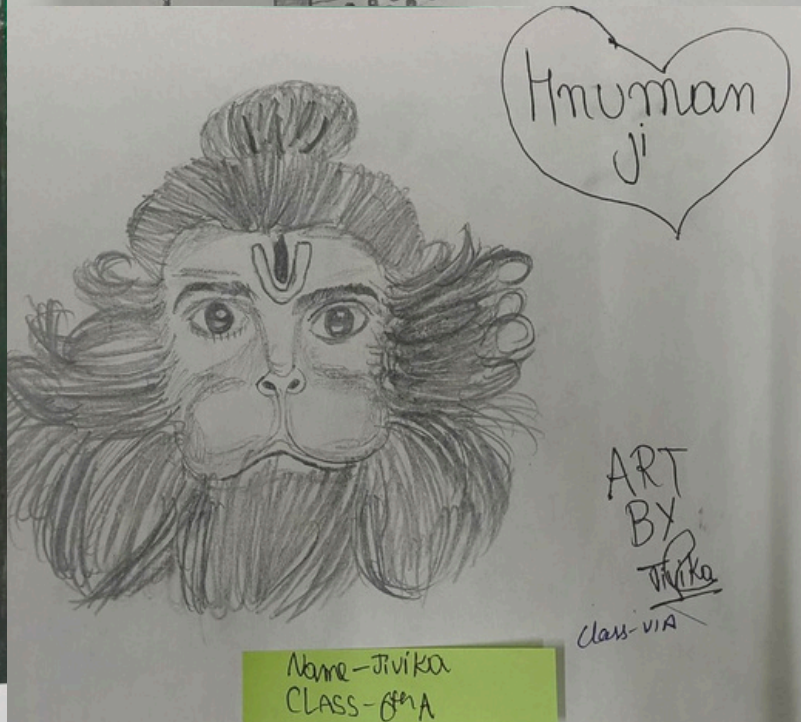
